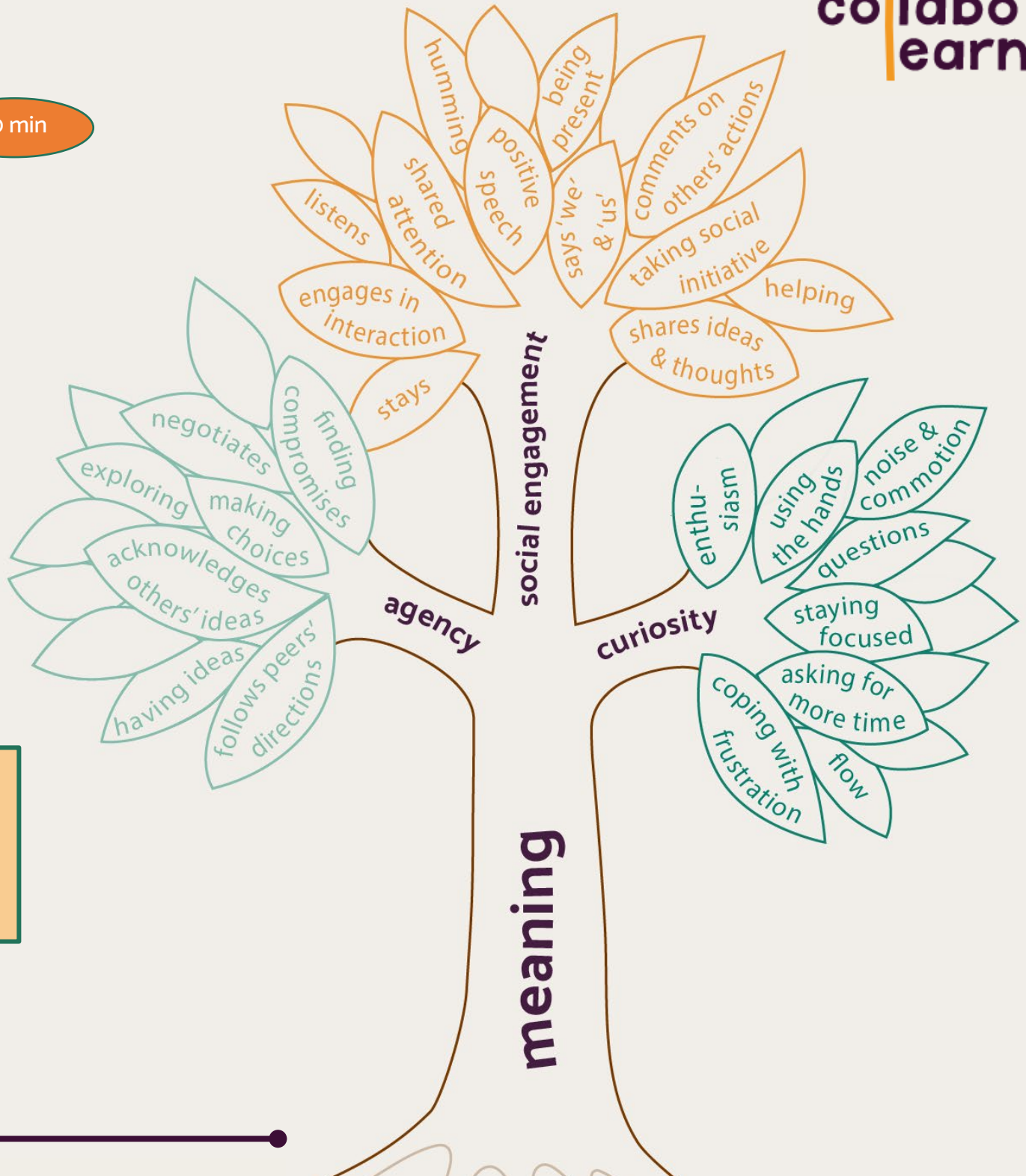

The indicators also allow us to create a common language for playful learning environments.

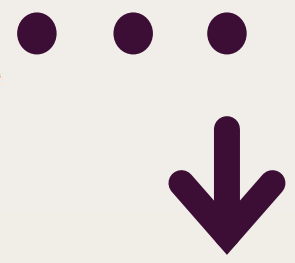
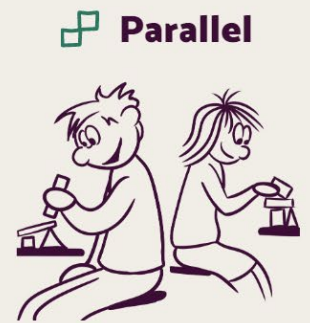
